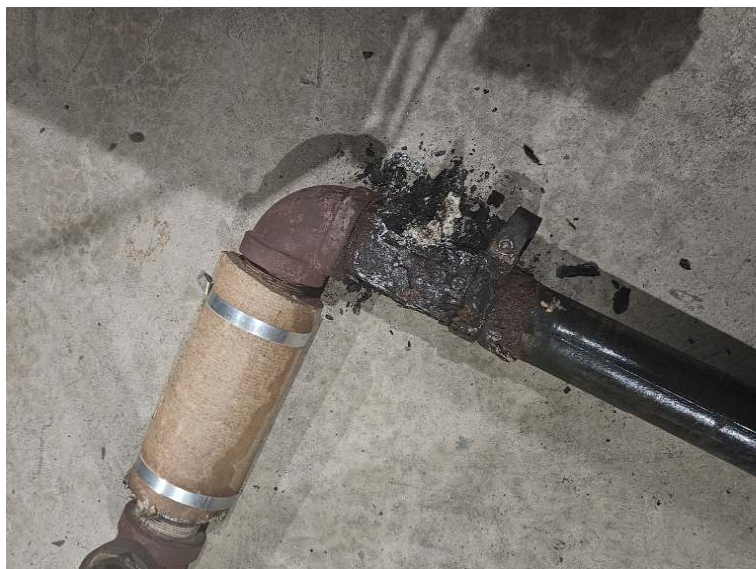

WE HAVE HEAT!

When Southern Air was performing our annual Preventive Maintenance & Startup of the boilers in September, they discovered a rusted out section of pipe in the ceiling that feeds hot water to the boiler in addition to an issue with the transformer on one of the boilers. We were advised to not start the heat until the pipe was repaired to avoid causing additional damage. We worked to find a contractor to perform the pipe repair and found Riddleberger Brothers based out of Mt. Crawford. The repair process that they recommended involved freezing the pipe, removing the old pipe and installing replacement pipe, and then unfreezing the pipe. This repair was performed on Wednesday, October 24th. We had to wait on the pipe to thaw before attempting to fire the boilers. We attempted to start them on Thursday, October 25th and were getting alarms on the system, so we contacted Southern Air to return and investigate that issue. They returned on Friday, October 25th and found a piece of the control module had failed causing the alarm. They immediately ordered the part and returned on Monday, October 28th to replace that part. At this time, we successfully started the boilers and monitored for alarms throughout the week.



Many thanks to our contractors, Southern Air & Riddleberger Brothers, for professional work and how quickly they were able to schedule and complete the work. Last month, the estate of Jeanne Lackey gifted WPC \$30,000, restricted to maintenance of WPC property, which was used to pay for these repairs. We are grateful for this gift to allow us to make this important repair. Finally, a huge thank you to Steve Ayers and Andy Shifflett who spent countless hours here over the last few weeks meeting contractors and monitoring the status of the boilers.



Thank you for your patience the last

few weeks as we got this repair completed and we pray that the heat will remain working throughout the winter season!

The Dream Team is excited to announce the next phase of the audio/visual renovations and updates.
