Westminster Presbyterian Church Sanctuary Update Ad Hoc Committee Charter

The Session of Westminster Presbyterian Church has approved and hereby commissions the Sanctuary Ad Hoc Committee to investigate and recommend a plan to update the Sanctuary of the church to set in motion the means to meet the following objective found in the Worship Theme of the Mission Study of the church approved in June of 2014:

- Modernize the Sanctuary to include upgraded sound equipment and dynamic audio-visual capability
- Reconfigure the Sanctuary to enhance the worship experience

Moreover, it is hoped that the findings of the committee will enable Westminster to establish facilities to meet the worshipping needs of everyone in the church community while enhancing the worship experience by:

- Establishing flexible worship space(s) that are satisfactory to meet the church's future needs with enhancements in design, and updates in the sound and visual systems.
- Accommodating the needs of members by taking into consideration potential physical limitations including decreased mobility and inability to negotiate constricted pathways and stairs.

The following are considered to be resources that the committee may choose to utilize in the course of their work:

- Members who have construction, remodeling experience
- Members who have design and architectural experience
- The *Worship Theme* of the Mission Study of the church
- The Lemons' previous proposal for audio-visual enhancements
- The Session of Westminster Presbyterian Church
- The Property Committee of Westminster Presbyterian Church

Time Frame — The Session requests that the recommendations of the committee be presented at the January 2016 meeting. Session welcomes input and attendance at any of its meetings from representatives of this committee.
